**GROUND RULES: PLEASE INITIAL AFTER EACH**

Advance written agreement/approval required prior to any sales  
Food Vendors ARE responsible for acquiring ALL necessary permits from City and  
County agencies and ensuring the Unity Rally chairperson receives a copy of  
PERMITS prior to December 30, 2019.

Vendors are responsible for acquiring LIABILITY INSURANCE for the event.

Vendors are required to have an INSURANCE RIDER (Certificate of Liability  
Insurance) for their participation. **NOTE:** The City and County of Honolulu and the  
Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Coalition-Hawaii must be listed on the insurance as co-  
insurers.

Twenty-five percent (25%) of proceeds will be donated to the Dr. Martin Luther King,  
Jr., Coalition-Hawaii upon final cash out at Kapiolani Park. The donations will be  
used to offset the expenses occurred for the event (i.e., police, rubbish cleanup,  
insurance, etc.). Penalties in the form of fees charged by the City and County of  
Honolulu for Vendor Violations will be paid for by the violator.

Vendors are required to completely set up and be ready for business by 10:00 am, January 20, 2020. Reserved parking will be made available to vendors beginning 6:30am, January 20, 2020 – (the day of the event).

ABSOLUTELY NO CASH TRANSACTIONS between vendor and customers. Violations will cause all monies to be forfeited to the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Coalition-Hawaii.

Vendors are required to sign-in with the Cashier's table beginning at 8:00 am. At this time, vendors can receive an advance in scrip to conduct business.

Vendors are responsible for the cleanliness of their areas during the Unity Rally and up to one (1) hour after the activities have concluded.

Vendors are required to complete and Fax the registration/contract along with insurance rider and permit (if applicable) to 808 693-9982 on or before December 30, 2019.

Prior approval is required for all participating vendors.

Non-food vendors are advised that merchandise on display and offered for sale to the public will not be contrary to the spirit of the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Holiday Celebration. The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Coalition-Hawaii reserves the right to update these rules without prior notice.
